- Be aware of the SFA's and the Club's Child and Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy and Procedures
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with coaches, officials, players, and volunteers based on mutual trust and respect
- Encourage players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Must at all times display exemplar standards of behaviour towards fellow and opposing team officials, volunteers, players, and parents/guardians
- Know where to find appropriate First Aid
- Promote ethical principles
